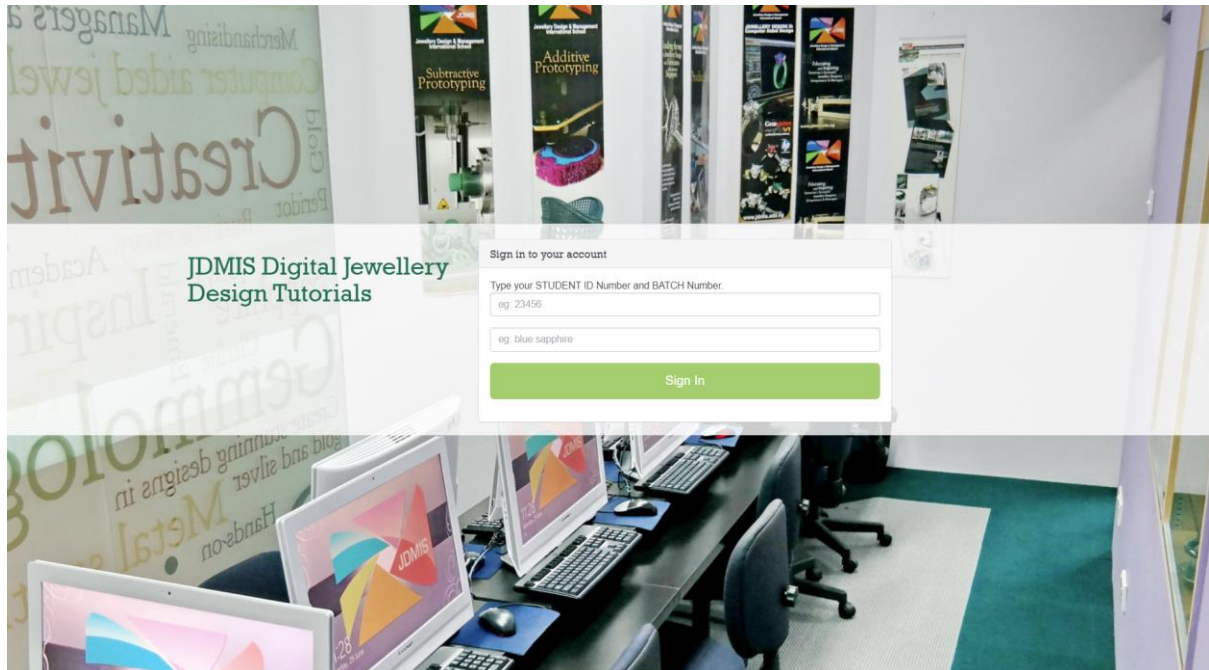

To help you in your practice during and after class, we have recorded step-by-step videos of the most important techniques to help you work through your lessons!



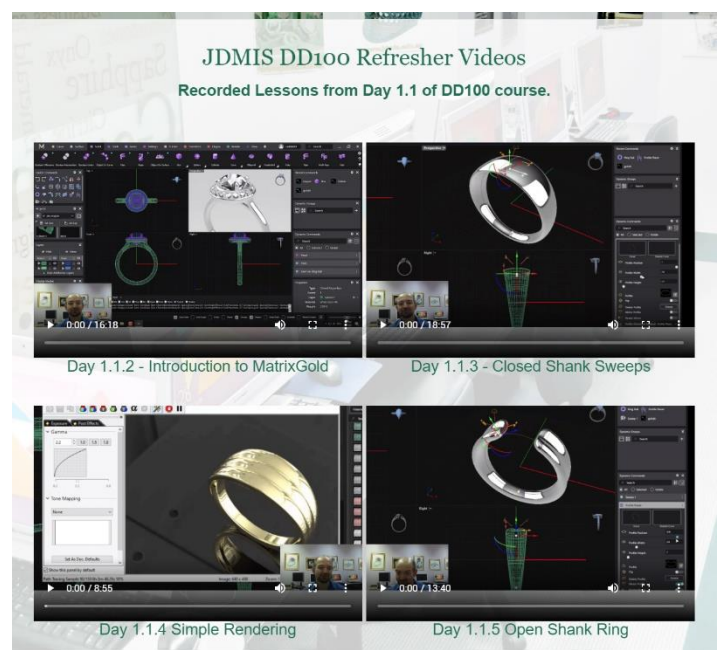

Remote Connect



Work on your CAD Projects from home

JDMIS' school machines can be accessed remotely from the comfort of your own home, which works very well you have a good internet connection.

JDMIS cannot provide "technical support" for this feature and cannot assist if your home network is not set up correctly, or if your computer firewall is blocking access. If it works for you, GREAT; if not, you may let me know to perform tests on our end to make sure all is working correctly on the school's side of the access.

If it's not a problem on the JDMIS' side but you continue to experience difficulties, then you may come in and use the computers for free at the school campus itself, or consider buying the student licence from GemVision and installing it on your computer.

If you are using a PC:

- Go to your start menu and search for "Remote Desktop"
- If you can't find it, go to "Start" -> "Run...", type MSTSC and then hit "Enter"
- If *that* doesn't work, you may download the program at:

🔔 **YOU MUST USE THIS VERSION** - old versions of the Mac Remote Desktop in the app store have not worked since 2012!

In the remote desktop client, type in the following:

- Computer: **cadlab.jdmis.edu.sg:** _____
- Username: **JDMIS** _____ (Note this is case sensitive!)
- Password: **JDMIS** (Note this is in all-caps!)

[The underscored blank spaces above are for writing in address/user details that are specific to **you only**, which will be provided to you by your lecturer – please approach them for assistance if the day's lesson concludes without you having received your personalized details]

Once in, you will be able to control the desktop as if you were at school.

When you are logged in, you will need to go to the start menu and you will find MatrixGold.

There are many other interesting features in Remote Desktop; one is an option to modify the settings and change to 'FULL SCREEN MODE' – if you manage this, it will feel most like you are actually working at the computer at school.

You can also configure Remote Desktop to share your own computer's drives and even printers – check out 'Help' if you want to find out more about some of these advanced features.

IMPORTANT NOTES!

- This is a SHARED RESOURCE.
Only one person can run matrix on the computer at one time. This means if you are working on Matrix, another user CANNOT.
In practice there are few occasions where more than one person tries to run MatrixGold simultaneously – if EVERYONE IS RESPONSIBLE.
- Please be polite and **LOG OFF** when you are done. (This is distinct from shutting-down the computer; **NEVER** choose the shut-down option!!)
- **DO NOT** leave MatrixGold running and just disconnect from the computer.

Remote access to your machines is **not** 'guaranteed' (remember you are sharing the computer with other students who may decide to come online at the same time as you do!) To minimize this type of 'traffic jam', you will only be granted 'priority' remote access to the machines for the duration of your course and a period of 2 weeks from the last day of your course.



IF YOU DISCONNECT WITHOUT CLOSING MATRIX, You will be warned.

If you persist in leaving matrix running without actually using it, your remote access will be TERMINATED for the benefit of the other CAD Lab Users.

For Q2 2020, JDMIS is working on a 'booking system' to allow remote access to be scheduled in advance for the convenience of JDMIS students and graduates.
