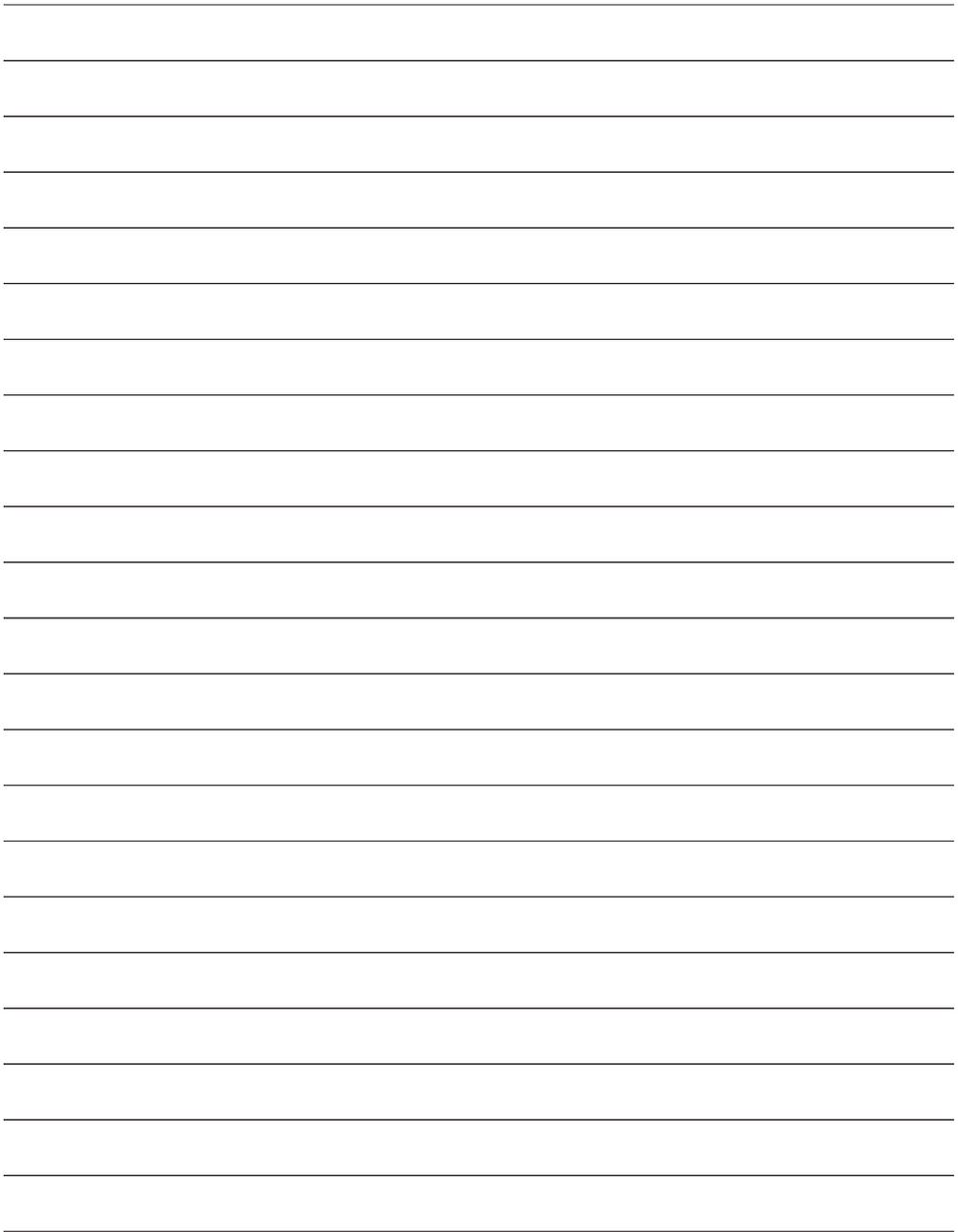


PROJECT FIVE HOLLOW DESIGNS









Make core shapes with the cork clay.



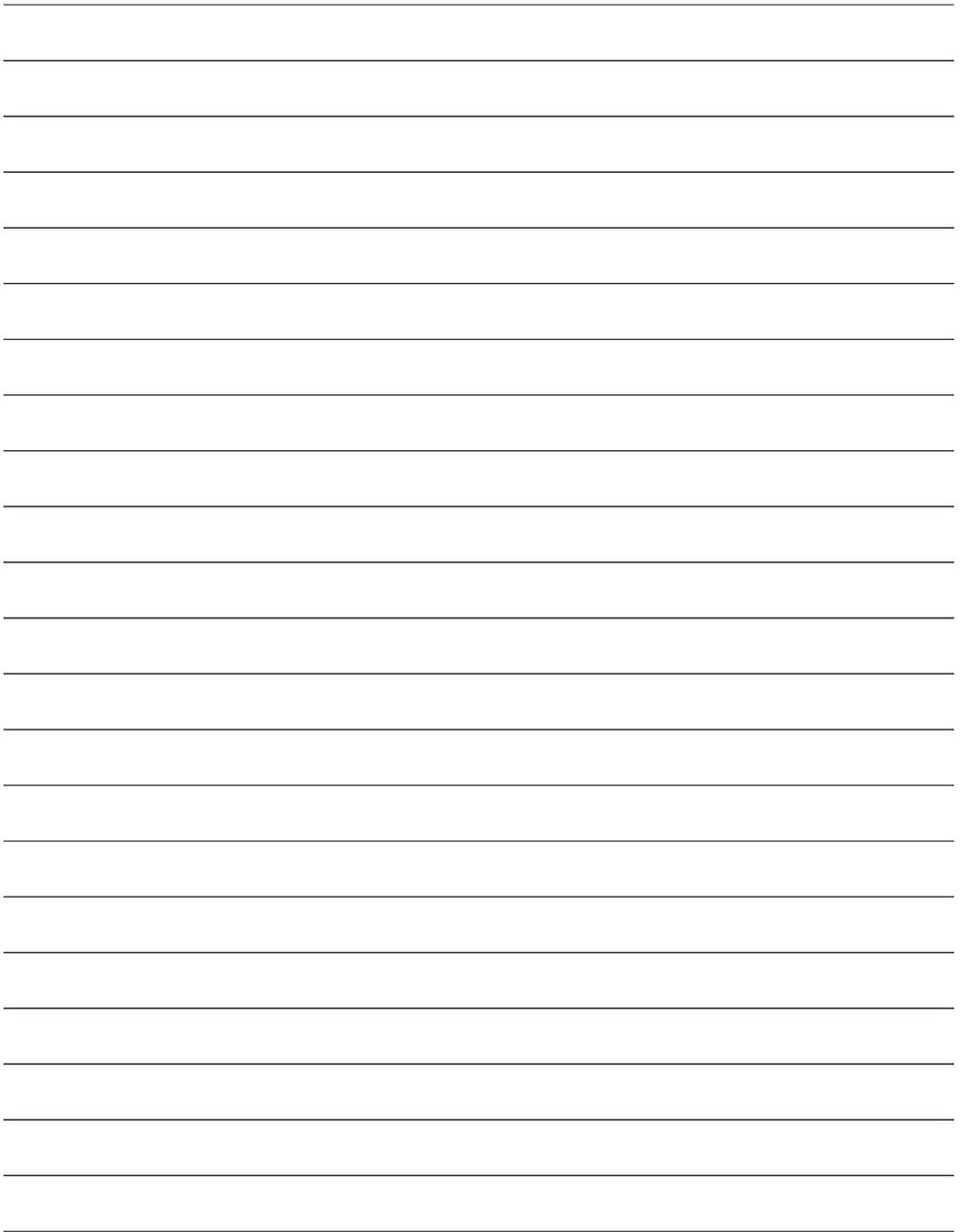
Put toothpicks through your core pieces and allow to fully dry for 3 days.




Start syringing around the drill holes first using the syringe type.




Continue to draw the pattern on the surface of the core as you rotate the toothpick.







5 Tap all overlapping clay strands with a damp paintbrush to ensure they connect securely.



6 Dry the piece for 2-3 minutes.




7 Reinforce weak areas with Paste-type material.




8 Dry the piece for at least 5 minutes.




File or sand the dried piece to smooth any rough edges.



To prevent deforming during firing lightly wrap with fibre-cloth and fire at 800° for 5 minutes.



Brush the entire piece with a stainless steel brush.



Use a burnisher on the edges and raised portions to further polish the piece. Press the side of the burnisher against the piece, and rub it while applying pressure. Be careful not to apply too much pressure!





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
